REUMAMAMA'S EN -PAPA'S

Tailor made information for 2 target groups:

- young (future) parents with an RMD
 - Heredity, medication and pregnancy, how to take care of a child while having an RMD
- parents of a child with an RMD
 - Juvenile Arthritis, psychological effects, school





YOUNG (FUTURE) PARENTS WITH RMD

- First session: Informal contact
 - Sharing personal stories, concerns, experiences
 - Mix of young parents with RMD and young patients with a child wish
 - Session guided by a rheuma nurse
 - Session planned in Reuma Expertise Huis (neutral ground)





YOUNG (FUTURE) PARENTS WITH RMD

- Second session: Clarification by specialists
 - Based on quotes and questions gathered during first session
 - Gynaecologist and rheumatologist
 - Topics: heredity, medication, pregnancy, delivery, (breast)feeding, practical tips and tricks for taking care of children

PARENTS OF A CHILD WITH AN RMD

- First session: Workshop psychological effects of having a child with RMD
 - Sharing personal stories, concerns, experiences
 - Supported by working group ORKA (Parents of RMD Children&Adolescents)
 - Guided by a private psychologist
 - Mixed group: parents of ORKA and 'new' parents





PARENTS OF A CHILD WITH AN RMD

- Second session: Clarification by specialists
 - Based on quotes and questions gathered during first session
 - Rheumatologists, paediatrician, psychologist and parents of ORKA
 - Topics: juvenile arthritis and treatment, the impact of a child with RMD on family, school

RESULTS

- Both sessions were well attended:
 - First session: 7 and 21 persons
 - Second session: 15 and 28 persons
- More inscriptions > attendees first target group:
 - Absence was RMD related (fatigue, pain, flare)
- > inscriptions second sessions:
 - Listening vs participation





RESULTS

- Correct information regarding:
 - Medication and pregnancy/breastfeeding, delivery, heredity, taking care of a child while having an RMD
 - The psychological impact of having a child with RMD on yourself as a parent, on family and school
 - Juvenile Arthritis

- ReumaNet is working on brochures:
 - Pregnancy and heredity
 - How to take care of children as a parent with RMD
 - Juvenile Arthritis
 - Proofread by specialists and patients
