

Survey ReumaNet 2015

- Developed by ReumaNet and her partners
- February June 2015
- Online survey with the help of Mediplanet
- Spreading through websites, social media, flyers, personal mailings...
- Around fifty paper surveys
 - Upon personal request
 - Via Patient organisations
 - Via rheumatologists
- TOTAL: 711 participants with rheumatic & musculoskeletal diseases (RMD's)








Conditions of participants:






"Each capsule contains your medication, plus a treatment for each of its side effects."





Questions about your relation with your physiotherapis general practitioner and pharmacist







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Did you easily find a physiotherapist that knows enough about your condition?





How satisfied are you with your physiotherapist?






16% gives 10/10

What do doctors think?

*(n=95), survey by Mediplanet

80% believe pts are more communicative than before

Doctors give themselves a score of 7,3/10 for communication

52% think pts are compliant to therapy 27% do not know

88% believe there is enough space and time to answer questions during consultations

44% think pts are well informed about their disease



How satisfied are you with the communication between your GP and rheumatologist?

8% give a 10/10 40% give a 5 or less




"I've been taking this medication for 50 years and I'm going to sue! The side effects made me wrinkled, fat and bald!"

Youth <26yrs are the least satisfied (7,5/10)


17% give a 10/10

What do pharmacists think?

*(n=139), survey by Mediplanet



83% believe pts are more communicative than before

Pharmacists give themselves a score of 7,5/10 for communication

44% believe pts are compliant to therapy
27% do not know

84% believe there is enough space and time to discuss questions

51% believe pts are well informed about their condition
















Conclusions:

- People with RMD's...
 - Want more information and communication about treatment and medication
 - Want more information and communication about future disease expectations
 - Are afraid of side effects of medication
 - Do not need to be reminded to take medication
 - Want to see 'fatigue' on the research agenda
 - Are moderately satisfied with the rheumatologist (7,4/10) and satisfied with GP/Pharmacist/Physiotherapist (8/10)
 - Want more communication between GP and rheumatologist (6/10)
 - Believe PO's to be useful for spreading information among patients and for advocacy work towards policy makers
